Croxley Green Permit Parking Zone 'CG'

The Croxley Green Permit Parking Zone ('Zone CG') helps to prioritise parking for people living locally and to improve safety and traffic flow in the roads shown on the map overleaf, next to Zone W, the *Winton Drive Zone*.

Parking bays are provided for anyone with a permit to park between 12pm and 1pm (Monday to Friday).

A range of permits are available to residents, their visitors and others who need nearby onstreet parking to visit residential addresses, such as Doctors and Health visitors, trades and builders.

Shoppers and other people who are visiting can park in the short-stay bays around the area and in the local car parks. Long-stay parking is available in Council car parks.

Permits must be displayed at all times during these hours. Parking across dropped kerbs within permit bays is unlawful (except your own driveway if a valid permit is displayed).

Resident Permits

Permits show that the vehicle has a valid reason to be parked in the Zone. Residents of residential addresses in the following streets will be able to apply for an annual permit for a vehicle they own, up to 2 permits per address. A permit can be used only within the zone for which it was issued.

- Dorrofield Close (All)
- Gonville Avenue (All)
- Hazelwood Road (All)
- New Road (Even numbers from no.85 to no.349; Odd numbers from no.68 to no.292 and including the Red House)
- The Crescent (All)
- Watford Road (Even numbers from no.10 to no.280; Odd numbers from no.5 to no.157)
- Dickinson Square (All)
- Beechcroft Avenue (All)

What do permits cost?

£38.00 for the first permit in a household and £69.00 for the second. First permits are free where there is a Blue Badge Driver in the household.

Visitor Vouchers

Each household is eligible for visitor vouchers, allowing parking for one day at a cost of £8 for ten. Apply here

Special permits

In exceptional circumstances, special permits may be offered, for example where severely disabled or older residents rely on family carers who need to visit to provide essential care. All applications must be supported by evidence.

You will need to prove that you live at an address in the Zone and that you own or use the vehicle.

Replacements and refunds

If you change your vehicle you also need to get your permit changed. For the first such change within 12 months there will be no charge.
