

RECYCLING GUIDE

Paper (Newspapers, magazines, printer paper, junk mail, shredded paper, envelopes including windows, wrapping paper/cards - no glitter, foil, or embellishments)

Food and drink cartons
(e.g. Tetra paks)

Cardboard (Toilet roll centres, corrugated card, cardboard boxes, sleeves and tubes)

Plastic pots, tubs and trays

Glass bottles/jars (any colour)

Plastic Bottles (Drinks, hand sanitiser bottles and cleaning/detergent bottles)

Aluminium foil/foil trays

Drink cans and food tins

Aerosol cans (empty only)



All items must be clean, empty, and placed in the bin loose.

Food must be recycled in your separate food waste bin.

Please do not place the following items in your recycling bin:

Textiles, nappies, paint tins, food waste, polystyrene, rigid plastics (toys), garden waste, electrical items, plastic bags/film, padded envelopes, paper towels/tissues, sanitary products, cotton wool, wet wipes, general trade waste, plastic pouches, biodegradable packaging, metal items (other than tins and cans) cookware, kitchenware, ceramics, glass kitchenware/drinking glasses, tyres, builders waste.
