Orchard	Fruit trees, grass	<input type="checkbox"/>
River	Flowing water, gravelly bed, aquatic plants	<input type="checkbox"/>
Pond	Small, still area of water, aquatic plants, algae	<input type="checkbox"/>
Urban	Buildings, paths, roads	<input type="checkbox"/>
