

STREET NAMING & NUMBERING FEES FROM 12th JANUARY 2026

The *allocation* of a new name or number is free of charge. There is a charge to notify statutory undertakers and other interested parties. When multiple plots are mentioned, the fee is a *total* price for the number of plots and not the fee for *individual* plots within that range.

Adding/removal or amendment of a house/business name	Formal notification for changes to relevant statutory undertakers (Royal Mail, emergency services etc.)	£144.00 per property
Re-issue of an official naming or numbering statement	Notification previously issued by the Council and sent to relevant statutory undertakers (Royal Mail, emergency services etc.)	£37.50
Changing an existing street name	Consultation with all residents/owners within the street is required, with the majority being in favour of the change.	Individually charged dependent on necessary workload and associated costs
