Three Rivers District Council pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council under section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000<sup>1</sup> and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000<sup>2</sup> in exercise of the powers conferred on the said County Council under sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>3</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said 1984 Act and in accordance with Regulation 21 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996<sup>4</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:-

## **PART I - PRELIMINARY**

### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Three Rivers (On-Street Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (No. 2) Order 2025 and shall come into force on 31 March 2025.

### **Interpretation**

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise required, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"All zones exemption" means an exemption granted by the Council at its discretion for the leaving of certain specified vehicles in parking places as are being used by Council staff, contractors, neighbouring councils or partnering organisations in the course of performing their duties, as may from time to time be authorised by the Council;

"Business permit" means a permit granted or issued under the provisions of Article 26;

"Business permit holder" means a person or organisation to whom a business permit has been issued or granted under the provisions of Article 26;

"Civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in section 76(5) of the Traffic Management Act 2004<sup>5</sup>;

"Council" means Three Rivers District Council and includes any parking services contractors or authorised agent appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order;

"Designated officer" means an officer of Three Rivers District Council nominated by the Head of Planning and Transportation or equivalent to carry out Council functions associated with the provisions of this Order;

"Disabled person's badge" and "disabled person's vehicle" have the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000<sup>6</sup>;

"Doctor and Health Visitor permit", hereafter referred to as a "DHV permit", means a permit granted or issued under the provisions of Article 43;

"DHV permit holder" means an organisation to whom a DHV permit has been issued or granted under the provisions of Article 43;

"Driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, loading place or restricted street, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place, loading place or restricted street, as the case may be;

"Electronic communications network" has the same meaning as in the Communications Act 2003<sup>7</sup>;

"Electronic permits system" means a computerised system operated by or on the behalf of the Council or its authorised agent which facilitates and records details pertaining to parking permits and which can transmit data to and receive data from hand-held devices;

"Electronic payment system" means an computerised system operated by or on the behalf of the Council or its authorised agent whereby the driver of a vehicle, or some other person authorised by that driver on their behalf, uses an electronic device to make payment of the parking charge in respect of a specified vehicle, a specified parking place and for a specified parking period by use of a debit or credit card and which records details pertaining to such payment, vehicle, parking place and parking period;

"Enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"Entitled business user" means a business or organisation which occupies premises the postal address of which has been either approved by the Council or by the Three Rivers Chamber of Trade and Commerce as being eligible for the grant or issue of a business permit;

"Goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"Goods vehicle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>8</sup>;

"Hand-held device", means an portable computing device which can transmit data to and receive data from the electronic permits system and electronic payments system for the purposes of verifying if valid permits have been granted or issued or payment of the parking charge has been made in respect of vehicles waiting in any parking place specified in the map-based schedule;

"Household" means a dwelling with a separate entry on the Council's Council Tax register;

"Loading place" means an area on a highway authorised as a loading place by this Order, being identified as such on the map tile relating to that loading place, by reference to the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both;

"Operational vehicle" means a vehicle operated by the entitled business user for the purposes of making deliveries, collections, servicing or such other business purposes as the Council shall approve;

"Owner", in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

"Map based schedule" means a collection of map tiles attached to this Order and listed in Schedule 1 which depict the parking places, loading places or waiting, loading or stopping restrictions designated, authorised or imposed, as the case may be, by this Order and, in conjunction with the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, identifies the type of each particular parking place, loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions and, if appropriate, certain of their governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place, loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions is depicted on the map based schedule, that parking place, loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data;

"Map schedule legend" means the map schedule legend attached to this Order which, when used in conjunction with a map tile, identifies the specific type of parking places, loading places or waiting, loading or stopping restrictions designated, authorised or imposed, as the case may be, by this Order and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions;

"Map tile" means an individual map with a specific tile reference, being part of the map based schedule attached to this Order;

"Maximum stay period", means the maximum period of time a vehicle may be left in or may wait in a parking place or loading place, as the case may be, specified in relation to each parking place or loading place by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both,

"Minimum return interval", means the minimum period of time before a vehicle, having been taken away from a parking place or loading place, may again be left in or may wait in that same parking place or loading place, as the case may be, specified in relation to each parking place or loading place by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both;

"No stopping hours", in relation to a restricted street, school keep clear marking or taxi rank, being the hours during which a vehicle may not stop whilst complying with the relevant provisions of this Order, means the time indicated by means of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that restricted street, school keep clear marking or taxi rank, as the case may be;

"Parking period" means a period of time either:-

- (a) for which payment of the parking charge has been made in respect of a vehicle and during which, subject to the provisions of this Order, that vehicle may be left in a pay and display parking place; or
- (b) during which, subject to the provisions of this Order, that vehicle may be left in a limited waiting time parking place, a shared-use residents' permit holders and limited waiting time parking place, or a shared-use residents' permit holders, business permit holders and limited waiting time parking place;

"Parking place" means an area on a highway either:-

- (a) designated as a parking place by this Order, being either a resident permit holders only parking place, a resident permit holders parking area, a pay and display parking place, a resident permit and disabled badge holders parking place, a resident permit holders and business permit holders parking place, a shared-use resident permit holders and limited waiting time parking place, a shared-use resident permit holders, business permit holders and limited waiting time parking place; or
- (b) authorised as a parking place by this Order, being either a limited waiting time parking place, or a disabled badge holders parking place;

and in each case being identified as such type on the map tile relating to that parking place, by reference to the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both;

"Parking ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine as indication of payment of the parking charge in respect of a pay and display parking place;

"Parking zone" means an area identified in column 1 of Schedule 2 as a parking zone comprising the streets listed in column 2 of Schedule 2;

"Passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor-cycle) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than- twelve passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

“penalty charge” shall have the same meaning as a charge set by the Council in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022<sup>9</sup> and the provisions of Part 6 and Schedule 9 of The Traffic Management Act 2004;

“penalty charge notice” shall mean a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022 and the provisions of Part 6 and Schedule 9 of The Traffic Management Act 2004;

“Permitted hours”, in relation to a parking place or loading place, means the time during which a vehicle may wait in a parking place or loading place whilst complying with the relevant provisions of this Order, means such period referred to by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in relation to that parking place or loading place;

“Prescribed hours”, in relation to a restricted street or taxi rank, being the hours during which a vehicle may not wait whilst complying with the relevant provisions of this Order, means the time indicated by means of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in relation to that restricted street or taxi rank, as the case may be;

“Relevant position” means either:-

- (a) in relation to the display of a permit or parking ticket issued under the provisions of this Order, on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle; or
- (b) in relation to the display of a disabled person’s badge, in accordance with Regulation 12 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000<sup>10</sup>;

and in all cases displayed in such a position as to be clearly visible from outside the front or nearside of the vehicle.

“Resident” means a person whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of any street described in Schedule 2;

“Residents’ permit” means a permit issued or granted under the provisions of Article 19;

“Residents’ permit holder” means a person to whom a permit has been issued or granted under the provisions of Article 19;

“Residents’ visitor’s permit” means a permit issued or granted under the provisions of Article 32;

“Residents’ visitor’s permit holder” means a person to whom a visitor’s permit has been issued or granted under the provisions of Article 32;

"Restricted hours", in relation to any restricted street, being the hours during which a vehicle may not wait for the purpose of loading or unloading that vehicle whilst complying with the relevant provisions of this Order, means the time indicated by means of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in relation to that restricted street;

"Restricted street" means any street or part of a street within the Three Rivers District identified by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, as having prescribed hours, restricted hours or no stopping hours applying to that street or length of street;

Provided that the expression "restricted street" shall not for the purpose of this Order include any area on a highway which is shown on a map tile designated or authorised as a parking place or loading place under the provisions of Part II of this Order.

"School keep clear marking" means a length of street on the highway, shown on the map schedule and identified as such on the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both;

"Special parking permit" means a permit issued or granted under the provisions of Articles 36 and 37;

"Special parking permit holder" means a person to whom a permit has been issued or granted under the provisions of Articles 36 and 37;

"Street" includes any part of a street;

"Taxi" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Taxi rank", means an area of carriageway reserved for use by taxis waiting to pick up passengers and identified as such by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both;

"Ticket machine" means an apparatus designed to indicate the time and to issue tickets indicating the payment of the parking charge and the periods in respect of which the parking charge has been paid; and

"Tile label", where shown on a map tile in relation to a parking place, loading place or length or waiting, loading or stopping restrictions, means a label which indicates, in conjunction with or in addition to the map schedule legend, the type of parking place, loading place or length or waiting, loading or stopping restrictions, as the case may be, and where appropriate, other applying conditions.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (4) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to wait:

- (a) in a parking place, loading place or restricted street if any point in that street is below the vehicle or its load (if any) and the vehicle is stationary; or
  - (b) for more than a specified period in the same place in a parking place, loading place or restricted street if any one point in that street is below the vehicle or its load (if any) throughout a period exceeding the specified period whether or not the vehicle is moved during that period.
- (5) Any reference in this Order to a length of restricted street shall, unless otherwise specified, be construed as a reference to the whole width of that length of street.
- (6) The Interpretation Act 1978<sup>11</sup> shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- (7) The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption from the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

## **PART II - DESIGNATION OR AUTHORISATION, AND USE OF PARKING PLACES AND LOADING PLACES**

### **Designation or authorisation of parking places and loading places**

3. (1) Each area on a highway comprising a length of carriageway of a street identified in the map based schedule and by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both, as either a resident permit holders only parking place, a pay and display parking place, a resident permit and disabled badge holders parking place, a resident permit and business permit parking place, a shared-use resident permit holders and limited waiting time parking place, or a shared-use resident permit holders, business permit holders and limited waiting time parking place, as the case may be, which, unless otherwise so specified, shall be bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of at least 1.8 metres, is hereby designated as a parking place.
- (2) Each area on a highway comprising a part or parts of the carriageway of a street identified in the map based schedule and by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both, as a resident permit holders parking area parking place, excluding any part of that area being a restricted street, during the prescribed hours, or restricted hours, or no stopping hours, as the case may be, in relation to that restricted street or which is authorised as a parking place other or a loading place under the provisions of this Order, is hereby designated as a parking place.
- (3) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street identified in the map based schedule and by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both, as either a limited waiting time parking place, or a disabled badge holders parking place, as the case may be, which, unless otherwise so specified, shall be bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of at least 1.8 metres, is hereby authorised as a parking place.
- (4) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street identified in the map based schedule and by way of the map schedule legend or a tile label, or both, as a loading place which, unless otherwise so specified, shall be bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is hereby authorised as a loading place.

### **Vehicles for which parking places and loading places are designated or authorised**

4. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Order, parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of vehicles of the following class, that is: passenger vehicles, goods vehicles (the overall height of which does not exceed 2.3 metres and the overall length of which does not exceed 5.25 metres), and motor cycles.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of this Order, loading places may be used for the waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading during the permitted hours of vehicles of the following class, that is: passenger vehicles, goods vehicles and motor cycles.

- (3) Resident permit holders only parking places may be used for the leaving during permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) above:-
- (a) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left, or as display in the manner specified in Article 5(1) a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (c) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit.
- (4) Resident permit holders parking area parking places may be used for the leaving during permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) above:-
- (a) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left, or as display in the manner specified in Article 5(1) a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (c) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit.
- (5) Limited waiting time parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) above for no longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to each parking place, provided that no vehicle may return to a parking place within the minimum return interval specified in relation to that parking place.
- (6) Pay and display parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) above as either:-
- (a) display in the manner specified in Article 5(2) a valid parking ticket; or
  - (b) in respect of which payment of the parking charge by way of the electronic payments system.

Provided that:-

- (i) no vehicle shall be left in a pay and display parking place:
  - (A) for longer than the parking period in respect of which payment of the parking charge has been made; or
  - (B) where a maximum stay period is specified in relation to that parking place, for longer than that maximum stay period; or

- (C) where no maximum stay period is specified in relation to that parking place, for a period of longer than 24 hours;
- and
- (ii) where a minimum return interval is specified in relation to a pay and display parking place, no vehicle may return to that parking place within that minimum return interval.
- (7) Disabled badge holders parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) as display in the manner specified in Article 2(4) a valid disabled person's badge.
- (8) Resident permit and disabled badge holders parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) as both:
  - (a) display in the manner specified in Article 2(4) a valid disabled person's badge; and
  - (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left.
- (9) Shared use resident permit holders and limited waiting time parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1), either:
  - (a) for no longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to each parking place, provided that no vehicle may return to a parking place within the minimum return interval specified in relation to that parking place; or
  - (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (c) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left, or as display in the manner specified in Article 5(1) a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (d) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit.
- (10) Resident permit holders and business permit holders parking places may be used for the leaving during permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1), either:
  - (a) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or

- (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a business permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (c) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left, or as display in the manner specified in Article 5(1) a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (d) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit.
- (11) Shared use resident permit holders, business permit holders and limited waiting time parking places may be used for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1), either:
- (a) for no longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to each parking place, provided that no vehicle may return to a parking place within the minimum return interval specified in relation to that parking place; or
  - (b) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (c) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a business permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (d) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left, or as display in the manner specified in Article 5(1) a residents' visitor's permit valid for the parking zone within which that vehicle is left; or
  - (e) in respect of which vehicle there has been issued or granted a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit.
- (12) Loading places may be used for waiting during the permitted hours of such vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(2) for the purposes of the loading onto or unloading from the vehicle of goods to or from premises located in the vicinity of a loading place, provided that no vehicle may wait in a loading place for no longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to each loading place, provided that no vehicle may return to a loading place within the minimum return interval specified in relation to that loading place.
- (13) Other than in accordance with the provisions of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in or wait in a parking place or loading place.

**Tickets or permits to be displayed on or indications by hand-held device in respect of vehicles left in parking places**

5. (1) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a resident permit holders only parking place or a resident permit holders parking area parking place during the permitted hours, either: the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid residents' permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that permit are readily visible from the outside, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that a valid residents' permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit has been granted in respect of that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order.
- (2) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours, either: the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid parking ticket issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that parking ticket are readily visible from the outside of that vehicle, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that payment of the parking charge has been made in respect of the vehicle using the electronic payment system, in accordance with the provisions of this Order.
- (3) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a disabled badge holders parking place during the permitted hours, the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
- (4) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a resident permit and disabled badge holders parking place during the permitted hours, the driver shall:
  - (a) cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid residents' permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that permit are readily visible from the outside of that vehicle, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that a valid residents' permit has been granted in respect of that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order;and
  - (b) cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
- (5) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a shared-use resident permit holders and limited waiting time parking place during the permitted hours for a period of time longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to the use of that parking place as a limited waiting time parking place as either: the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid residents' permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that permit are readily visible from the outside, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that a valid residents' permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit has been granted in respect of that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

- (6) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a resident permit holders and business permit holders parking place during the permitted hours, either: the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that permit are readily visible from the outside, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that a valid residents' permit or a valid business permit or a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit has been granted in respect of that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order.
- (7) At all times during which a vehicle is left in a shared-use resident permit holders, business permit holders and limited waiting time parking place during the permitted hours for a period of time longer than the maximum stay period specified in relation to the use of that parking place as a limited waiting time parking place as either: the driver shall cause to be displayed in the relevant position a valid residents' permit, a valid business permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order so that all the particulars on that permit are readily visible from the outside, or there shall be an indication by hand-held device that a valid residents' permit, a valid business permit, a valid residents' visitor's permit or a valid special parking permit or a valid DHV permit has been granted in respect of that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

#### **Contravention of this Order in relation to parking places and loading places**

6. (1) If a vehicle is left or is waiting in a parking place or loading place during the permitted hours without complying with the provisions of this Order, then a contravention of, or failure to comply with this Order shall be deemed to have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022.
- (3) The penalty charge shall be paid to Three Rivers District Council in accordance with the instructions and within the time limits specified on the penalty charge notice.

#### **Alteration of position of a vehicle in a parking place or loading place**

7. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place or loading place in contravention of the provisions of Article 10, a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

**Movement of a vehicle in a parking place or loading place in an emergency**

8. A police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may, in case of emergency, move or cause to be moved to any place they think fit, any vehicle left in a parking place or loading place.

## **Exemptions for certain vehicles**

9. (1) A disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge may be left in a pay and display parking place without time limit, provided that the use of that parking place in which the vehicle is left has not been suspended, and no parking charge shall be incurred or payable in respect of that vehicle.
- (2) Where this Order prescribes a maximum stay period or, where applicable, a maximum stay period and minimum return interval, in relation to a parking place, those time periods shall not apply to any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge.
- (3) A motor cycle may be left in a pay and display parking place without time limit, provided that the use of that parking place in which the vehicle is left has not been suspended, and no parking charge shall be incurred or payable in respect of that vehicle.
- (4) A vehicle in respect of which has been granted an all zones exemption duly authorised by the Council, may be left in any parking place without time limit, provided that the vehicle is being used in the course of the carrying out of such duties in respect of which said all zones exemption has been granted, and that the use of that parking place in which the vehicle is left has not been suspended, and no parking charge shall be incurred or payable in respect of that vehicle.
- (5) Without prejudice to the generality of this Article, and notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, a disabled person's vehicle or motor cycle or vehicle in respect of which has been granted an all zones exemption shall stand in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of Article 10.

## **PART III – SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO PARKING PLACES AND LOADING PLACES**

### **Section 1 – General**

#### **Manner of standing in a parking place or loading place**

10. Every vehicle left in a parking place or loading place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall so stand:
- (a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place is identified on the highway by means of appropriate road markings or the placing of an appropriate sign nearby, or both, as to be in accordance with that identification or sign, or both;
  - (b) in the case of any other parking place or loading place, so that:
    - (i) in the case of a vehicle other than a motor cycle, the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle; or
    - (ii) in the case of a motor cycle, the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is perpendicular to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle;and the wheels of the vehicle are not more than 300 millimetres away from the edge of the carriageway nearest the vehicle; and
  - (c) that every part of a vehicle is within the limits of a parking place or loading place.

#### **Power to suspend the use of a parking place or loading place**

11. (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council or the Police may suspend the use of a parking place or loading place, or any part thereof, whenever they consider such suspension reasonably necessary:
- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety; or
  - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or loading place, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies in or adjacent to the parking place or loading place, the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place or loading place of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications network or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign; or
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place or loading place on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from one office or dwelling-house adjacent to the parking place or loading place from or to a depository, another office or dwelling-house; or
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or

- (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place or loading place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (2) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a parking place or loading place or any part thereof whenever they consider such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- (3) Any authorised person or police constable in uniform suspending the use of a parking place or loading place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or, as the case may be, paragraph (2) of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or loading place or part thereof a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be waiting at a parking place or loading place or any part thereof during which such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or loading place or part thereof a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3) above provided that nothing in this paragraph shall apply –
  - (a) in respect to any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle which is waiting for any reason specified in Article 13(1) (b), (d) or (e); or
  - (b) to anything done with permission of the person suspending the use of the parking place or loading place or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article or a police constable in uniform.

### **Restriction on the use of a parking place or loading place**

12. During the permitted hours no person shall use any parking place or loading place or any vehicle while it is in a parking place or loading place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of any goods to any person in or near the parking place or loading place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of their skill in handicraft or their services in any other capacity:

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle:

- (1) if the vehicle is a passenger vehicle, a goods vehicle, or a motor cycle and the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected; or
- (2) if the vehicle is one to which the provisions of Article 13(1)(h) apply.

### **Restriction on waiting by a vehicle in a parking place or loading place**

- 13 (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a parking place or loading place if the use of that part has not been suspended and if:
- (a) the vehicle is waiting for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling any person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
  - (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
  - (c) the vehicle is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or, not being a passenger vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
  - (d) the vehicle is waiting for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (e) the vehicle is waiting:
    - (i) while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place or loading place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered; or
    - (ii) while postal packets are being collected for the loading on the vehicle from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place or loading place in which the vehicle is waiting or, having been so collected, are being unloaded thereon;
  - (f) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle is waiting only for as long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose specified in Article 11(1)(b),
  - (g) the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from an office or a dwelling-house adjacent to the parking place or loading place from or to a depository, another office or dwelling-house;
  - (h) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place or loading place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for a period exceeding twenty minutes or for such longer period as a civil enforcement officer may approve.
- (2) No parking charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a parking place or loading place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.

- (3) Except as provided by this Order, the driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall not cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place or loading place during the permitted hours.
- (4) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place or loading place by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article shall cause it so to stand in accordance with the provisions of Article 10.
- (5) Nothing in the provisions of this Order shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any regulations made or having effect as if made under section 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Placing of traffic signs, etc.**

14. The Council shall:

- (1) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place and loading place;
- (2) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place and loading place traffic signs indicating that such parking places or loading places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving or waiting, as the case may be, of the vehicles specified in Article 4 in relation to that type of parking place or loading place only; and
- (3) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place or loading place.

## **Section 2 – The parking charge and indications by parking ticket, ticket machine and the electronic payment system**

### **Amount of the parking charge and maximum stay periods**

15. (1) The parking charge for a vehicle (other than a vehicle otherwise exempted by this Order) left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours shall, subject as hereinafter provided, be as specified in item 1 of Schedule 3.
- (2) Where payment of the parking charge has been made in respect of a vehicle left in a pay and display parking place, the parking period shall not exceed any maximum stay period specified in relation to that parking place.

### **Payment of the parking charge**

16. (1) Payment of the parking charge shall be made, in accordance with the next following paragraph, immediately after a vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place.
- (2) The parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of a vehicle in a pay and display parking place either:-
  - (a) by the insertion of coins of an appropriate denomination together making up the amount of the parking charge for the parking period for which payment is being made in a ticket machine relating to that parking place, following which the driver shall display or cause to be displayed on that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) below, the parking ticket issued; or
  - (b) where a ticket machine situated in the parking place in which the vehicle is left accepts a credit card or a debit card, by the insertion in that ticket machine of a valid credit card or debit card (which shall be debited with the amount of the parking charge for the parking period for which payment is being made), following which the driver shall display or cause to be displayed on that vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) below, the parking ticket issued; or
  - (c) using the electronic payment system;  
and by following the instructions for payment of the parking charge as indicated on that ticket machine or, as the case may be on a sign relating to that parking place.  

Provided that, where only one of the methods of payment referred to in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) above is available, that method shall be used for payment of the parking charge.
- (3) The parking ticket referred to in the last preceding paragraph shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours, so that all the particulars on that side of the parking ticket which bears the indication that a parking charge has been paid and the day and time by which the parking period will expire, are readily visible from the outside of and front or nearside of the vehicle.

- (4) In any case where there is over a ticket machine a notice, placed by any person duly authorised by the Council or authorised agent or by the Police, indicating that every ticket machine relating to a parking place is out of order, the parking place shall be taken as being suspended and parking prohibited.
- (5) In any case where payment of the parking charge as described in paragraph (2)(a) or (b) of this Article has been made and a parking ticket has been issued by a ticket machine in respect of a vehicle left in a pay and display parking place, that parking ticket shall not be transferred to another vehicle under any circumstances.
- (6) No refund shall be payable in respect of any parking ticket surrendered to the Council, or of any payment of the parking charge, other than at the discretion of the Council.

**Indications and evidence by parking ticket, ticket machine and hand held device**

17. (1) Payment of the parking charge in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated:-
  - (a) where such payment is made in accordance with either Article 16(2)(a) or 16(2)(b), by the issue by a ticket machine of a parking ticket indicating that a parking charge has been paid and the date and time of expiry of the parking period, and by the display of that parking ticket in the manner specified in Article 16(3); or
  - (b) where such payment is made in accordance with Article 16(2)(c), by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that the parking charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle by using the electronic payment system and an indication of the date and time of expiry of the parking period for which such parking charge has been paid.
- (2) Where payment of the parking charge is made:
  - (a) in accordance with either Article 16(2)(a) or 16(2)(b), the expiry of the parking period in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated when there is displayed on the vehicle a parking ticket showing the date and time of expiry of the parking period, and the date so shown is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the time shown on the clock of the ticket machine that issued the parking ticket is later than the time of expiry of the parking period shown on the parking ticket; or
  - (b) in accordance with Article 16(2)(c), the expiry of the parking period in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that the parking period for which payment of the parking charge has been made has expired.
- (3) Subject to Articles 9 and 13, if at any time during which a vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours and no parking ticket is displayed on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 16(3) and no indication appears on a hand-held device that payment of the parking charge has been made in accordance with the provisions of Article

16(2)(c), it shall be presumed that the parking charge has not been duly paid in respect of that vehicle.

- (4) Subject to Articles 9 and 13, if at any time during which a vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours and the parking ticket displayed on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 16(3) shows a date that is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the clock on the ticket machine that issued the parking ticket is later than the time shown on that parking ticket and no indication appears on a hand-held device that the parking charge has been paid in respect that vehicle by the electronic payment system on the date on which the vehicle is left, it shall be presumed that the parking period for which payment of parking charge was made has expired.
- (5) Subject to Articles 9 and 13, if at any time during which a vehicle is left in a pay and display parking place during the permitted hours and the parking ticket displayed on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 16(3) shows a date that is not the date on which the vehicle is left or the clock on the ticket machine that issued the parking ticket is later than the time shown on that parking ticket and an indication appears on a hand-held device showing that the parking charge has been paid on the date on which the vehicle is so left but that the parking period has expired, it shall be presumed that the parking charge has been duly paid in respect of that vehicle and that the parking period has expired.
- (6) If it is presumed:-
  - (a) in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of this Article, that the parking charge has not been duly paid; or
  - (b) in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) or (5) of this Article, that the parking period has expired;then either of these indications shall be evidence that a contravention of this Order has occurred for the purposes of Article 6.
- (7) A parking ticket shall be presumed to have been issued on the date and at the time shown on that parking ticket.

#### **Restriction on removal of parking tickets or permits**

18. Where a parking ticket or a permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the parking ticket or a permit from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

### **Section 3 – Application for and grant or issue of permits**

#### **Application for and grant or issue of residents' permits**

19. (1) Any resident residing at a qualifying address within one of the Parking Zones listed in Schedule 2, who is the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4(1) may apply to the Council for the grant or issue of a residents' permit relating to the parking zone within which they reside in respect of that vehicle and any such application shall be made by way of the Council's on-line parking permits application system, accessed by way of the Council's website, and shall include the particulars and information required by such application system to be supplied.
- (2) Any resident residing at a qualifying address within parking zone 'A1', as listed in Schedule 2, who is the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4(1) may apply to the Council for the grant or issue of a residents' permit relating to both parking zones 'A' and 'A1' in respect of that vehicle and any such application shall be made by way of the Council's on-line parking permits application system, accessed by way of the Council's website, and shall include the particulars and information required by such application system to be supplied.
- (3) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a residents' permit or a residents' permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council or authorised agent such evidence in respect of an application for a residents' permit made to them as they may reasonably call to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any residents' permit granted or issued by them as they may reasonably call for to verify that the residents' permit is valid.
- (4) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article and upon receipt of the charge specified in item 2 of Schedule 3, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4(1), shall grant or issue to the applicant a residents' permit for the leaving during the permitted hours in a parking place of the vehicle to which such residents' permit relates by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward.
- (5) The Council shall grant or issue residents' permits subject to such terms and conditions as may be set by the council from time to time.

#### **Limit on the number of residents' permits to be granted or issued to a household**

20. Subject to the provisions of Article 22, the Council shall not grant or issue a residents' permit during any calendar year to a resident in any household in respect of which, either:-
  - (a) in the case of a residents' permit granted or issued in respect of any parking zone other than parking zones 'BED' or 'E', two other residents' permits have been granted or issued and remain valid during that period; or

- (b) in the case of a residents' permit granted or issued in respect of parking zones 'BED' or 'E', one other residents' permit has been granted or issued and remains valid during that period.

### **Refund of charge paid in respect of a residents' permit**

- 21. A residents' permit holder who surrenders to the Council or authorised agent a residents' permit under the provisions of paragraph (3)(a) or paragraph (3)(b) of Article 22 either before or after the residents' permit has become valid may, at the discretion of the Council, be entitled to a refund in respect of the unexpired period of part of the fee paid in respect of the residents' permit calculated on a pro rata basis, subject to the administration fee set out in item 5(b) of Schedule 3.

### **Surrender, withdrawal and validity of residents' permits**

- 22. (1) A residents' permit holder may surrender a residents' permit to the Council or authorised agent at any time and shall surrender a residents' permit to the Council or authorised agent on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article or in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article.
- (2) The Council or authorised agent may, by notice in writing served on the residents' permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the residents' permit holder at the address provided by that person at time of application for the residents' permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a residents' permit if it appears to the Council or authorised agent that any of the events set out in paragraph (3)(a), (b) or (d) of this Article has occurred and the residents' permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council or authorised agent within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.
- (3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:
  - (a) the residents' permit holder ceasing to be a resident within the parking zone in respect of which the residents' permit was granted or issued;
  - (b) the residents' permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the residents' permit was granted or issued;
  - (c) the withdrawal of such residents' permit by the Council or authorised agent under the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article;
  - (d) the vehicle in respect of which such residents' permit was granted or issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4(1);
  - (e) the grant or issue of a duplicate residents' permit by the Council under the provisions of Article 23;
  - (f) the residents' permit ceasing to be valid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article.

- (4) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article and the provisions of the next following paragraph, a residents' permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified thereon, or on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in sub-paragraphs (3)(a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) of this Article, whichever is the earlier.
- (5) Where a residents' permit is granted or issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque or credit card payment and the payment is subsequently dishonoured, the residents' permit shall cease to be of any effect and the Council shall by notice in writing served on the person to whom such residents' permit was granted or issued by sending the same by recorded delivery service to the residents' permit holder at an address provided by that person at the time of application for the residents' permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, require that person to surrender the residents' permit to the Council or within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

#### **Application for and grant or issue of duplicate residents' permits**

23. (1) Where a residents' permit has been issued as a printed document, if that residents' permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the residents' permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the residents' permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council and apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate residents' permit and the Council, upon receipt of the residents' permit and the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall either grant or issue a duplicate residents' permit, so marked where issued as a printed document. Upon such grant or issue the original residents' permit shall become invalid.
- (2) If a residents' permit issued as a printed document is lost or destroyed, the residents' permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to them of a duplicate residents' permit and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction and upon receipt of the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall issue a duplicate residents' permit, so marked, and upon such issue the original residents' permit shall become invalid.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate residents' permit and an application therefor as if it were a residents' permit or, as the case may be, an application therefor.

#### **Restriction on the removal of residents' permits**

24. Where a residents' permit has been displayed in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, no person other than the driver of the vehicle shall remove the residents' permit unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle. Provided that nothing herein shall apply to a civil enforcement officer or a person removing the vehicle in pursuance of an arrangement made by the civil enforcement officer by or under regulations in pursuance of powers contained in sections 99, 100, 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### **Form of residents' permits**

25. Where issued as a printed document, a residents' permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
- (1) the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which the residents' permit has been issued;
  - (2) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 22, the residents' permit shall remain valid;
  - (3) an indication that the residents' permit has been issued by the Council; and
  - (4) an indication of the parking zone or zones within which the use of the residents' permit is valid.

### **Application for and grant or issue of business permits**

26. (1) Any entitled business user that uses a vehicle or vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) which is essential to their business may apply to the Council for the grant or issue of a business permit relating to the parking zone in which their business is located or operates in respect of that vehicle or vehicles and any such application shall be made by way of the Council's on-line parking permits application system, accessed by way of the Council's website, and shall include the particulars and information required by such application system to be supplied.
- (2) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a business permit or a business permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council or authorised agent such evidence in respect of an application for a business permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any business permit granted or issued by them as they may reasonably call for to verify that the business permit is valid.
- (3) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article, and upon receipt of the charge specified in item 3 of Schedule 3 hereto, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is an entitled business user and is the user of a vehicle or vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1), shall grant or issue to the applicant therefor one business permit for the leaving during the permitted hours in a parking place of the vehicle or vehicles to which such business permit relates by the user of such vehicle or vehicles or by any person using such vehicle or vehicles with the consent of the user, other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward.

Provided that:

- (a) where a business permit has been issued or granted in respect of two vehicles, that permit may only be deemed valid for use in a parking place in respect of one vehicle at a time; and
- (b) a business permit shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from the date on which the business permit first becomes valid; and

- (c) the Council shall not grant or issue a business permit to any entitled business user during the period of validity of any business permit previously issued in respect of the entitled business user, subject to the provisions of Article 28.

### **Refund of charge paid in respect of business permits**

27. A business permit holder who surrenders to the Council or authorised agent a business permit under the provisions of paragraph (3)(a) or paragraph (3)(b) of Article 28 either before or after the business permit has become valid may, at the discretion of the Council, be entitled to a refund in respect of the unexpired period of part of the fee paid in respect of the business permit calculated on a pro rata basis, subject to the administration fee set out in item 5(b) of Schedule 3 .

### **Surrender, withdrawal and validity of business permits**

28. (1) A business permit holder may surrender a business permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender a business permit to the Council on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article or in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article.
- (2) The Council may by notice in writing served on the business permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the business permit holder at the address provided by the entitled business user at time of application for the business permit or at any other address believed to be their place of business, withdraw a business permit if it appears to the Council that any of the events set out in paragraph (3)(a) or (b) of this Article has occurred and the business permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council or authorised agent within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.
- (3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:
- (a) the business permit holder ceasing to be an entitled business user at the address in respect of which the business permit was granted or issued;
  - (b) the business permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle or vehicles in respect of which the business permit was granted or issued;
  - (c) the withdrawal of such business permit by the Council under the provision of paragraph (2) of this Article;
  - (d) the grant or issue of a duplicate business permit by the Council under the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article.
- (4) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article a business permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified at time of granting or issue or on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph 3(a), (b), (c) or (d) of this Article whichever is the earlier.

- (5) Where a business permit is granted or issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque or credit card and the payment is subsequently dishonoured the business permit shall cease to be of any effect and the Council shall by notice in writing served on the business permit holder to whom such business permit was granted or issued by sending the same by recorded delivery service to the business permit holder at the address provided at time application for the business permit or at any other address believed to be their place of business, require that business permit holder to surrender the business permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

#### **Application for and grant or issue of duplicate business permits**

29. (1) If a business permit issued as a printed document is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figure or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the business permit has become altered by fading or otherwise the business permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council or apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate business permit and the Council upon receipt of the business permit and the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall grant or issue a duplicate business permit, so marked where issued as a printed document, and upon such grant or issue the business permit shall become invalid.
- (2) If a business permit issued as a printed document is lost or destroyed the business permit holder may apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate business permit and the Council upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction, and upon receipt of the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall grant or issue a duplicate business permit, so marked where issued as a printed document, and upon such issue the business permit shall become invalid.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate business permit and an application therefor as if it were a business permit or as the case may be an application therefor.

#### **Restriction on the removal of business permits**

30. Where a business permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 no person other than the driver of the vehicle shall remove the business permit unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle provided that nothing herein shall apply to a civil enforcement officer or a person removing the vehicle in pursuance of an arrangement made by the civil enforcement officer by or under regulations in pursuance of powers contained in sections 99, 100, 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### **Form of business permits**

31. Where issued as a printed document, a business permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
- (1) the registration marks of the vehicle or vehicles in respect of which the business permit has been issued;
  - (2) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 28(4), the business permit shall remain valid;
  - (3) an indication that the business permit has been issued by the Council;
  - (4) an indication of the parking zone within which the business permit is valid.

### **Application for and grant or issue of residents' visitor's permits**

32. (1) Any resident, residing at a qualifying address within parking zones 'A', 'A1', 'B', 'C', 'C1', 'D', 'NS', 'GS', 'NL', 'OW', 'OZ' or 'W', as listed in Schedule 2, may apply to the Council for the grant or issue of either:-
- (a) one annual residents' visitor's permit, valid for one year; or
  - (b) a number of one-day residents' visitor's permits, each valid for up to a maximum of 24 hours from the time and date indicated on the permit;
- or both, subject to the provisions of Article 33, for a vehicle or vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) and any such application shall be made by way of the Council's on-line parking permits application system, accessed by way of the Council's website, and shall include the particulars and information required by such application system to be supplied.
- Provided that annual residents' visitor's permits shall not be available to residents residing at addresses within parking zones 'E', 'BED' and 'RG'.
- (2) The Council or authorised agent may at any time require an applicant for a residents' visitor's permit or a residents' visitor's permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council or authorised agent such evidence in respect of an application for a residents' visitor's permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any residents' visitor's permit granted or issued by them as they may reasonably call for to verify that the residents' visitor's permit is valid.
  - (3) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and possesses a valid residents' permit and upon receipt of the relevant charge specified in item 4 of Schedule 3 hereto, shall grant or issue to the applicant therefor either an annual residents' visitor's permit or a number of one-day residents' visitor's permits, or both, for the leaving of a vehicle of the class referred to in Article 4(1) in a parking place during the permitted hours and subject to terms and conditions as are set by the Council in relation to the use of the residents' visitor's permit or permits.
  - (4) For applications where a resident does not possess a valid residents' permit the applicant may apply for a special parking permit for visitors to use, granted or issued at the discretion of the Council.

### **Surrender, withdrawal and validity of residents' visitor's permits**

33. (1) A residents' visitor's permit shall cease to be valid for use on the expiration of the date indicated either on the permit or by hand-held device in relation to the permit.
- (2) A residents' visitor's permit holder may surrender a residents' visitor's permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender a residents' visitor's permit to the Council on the occurrence of the residents' visitor's permit holder ceasing to be a resident in the parking zone in respect of which the residents' visitor's permit was granted or issued.
- (3) The Council may, by notice in writing served on the residents' visitor's permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the residents' visitor's permit holder at the address provided by that person at time of application for the residents' visitor's permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a residents' visitor's permit if it appears to the Council that the residents' visitor's permit holder has ceased to be a resident and the residents' visitor's permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

### **Application for and grant or issue of duplicate residents' visitor's permits and exchange of unused residents' visitor's permits**

34. (1) Where an annual residents' visitor's permit has been issued as a printed document, if that annual residents' visitor's permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the annual residents' visitor's permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the residents' visitor's permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council and apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate annual residents' visitor's permit and the Council, upon receipt of the annual residents' visitor's permit and the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall either grant or issue a duplicate annual residents' visitor's permit, so marked where issued as a printed document. Upon such grant or issue the original annual residents' visitor's permit shall become invalid.
- (2) If an annual residents' visitor's permit issued as a printed document is lost or destroyed, the residents' visitor's permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to them of a duplicate annual residents' visitor's permit and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction and upon receipt of the administration fee set out in item 5(a) of Schedule 3, shall issue a duplicate annual residents' visitor's permit, so marked, and upon such issue the original annual residents' visitor's permit shall become invalid.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate residents' visitor's permit and an application therefor as if it were a residents' visitor's permit or, as the case may be, an application therefor.
- (4) A resident applying for one-day residents' visitor's permits according to the provisions of Article 32 is not entitled to exchange unused one-day residents' visitor's permits unless the Council in its discretion considers there are exceptional circumstances to justify an exchange, in which case

new one-day residents' visitor's permits valid for the subsequent year will be supplied in exchange for the unused one-day residents' visitor's permits.

### **Restriction on the removal of residents' visitor's permits**

35. Where a residents' visitor's permit has been displayed in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle shall remove the residents' visitor's permit unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle. Provided that nothing herein shall apply to a civil enforcement officer or a person removing the vehicle in pursuance of an arrangement made by the civil enforcement officer by or under regulations in pursuance of powers contained in sections 99, 100, 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### **Application for and issue or grant of special parking permits**

36. (1) Any resident residing at a qualifying address within a parking zone (or any person acting on behalf of such a resident) may at any time apply to the Council for the issue of a special parking permit in respect of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4(1) identifying the user of the vehicle. The decision to grant or issue a special parking permit is at the discretion of the Council's Designated Officer. Without prejudice to the generality of the Council's Designated Officer's discretion the following circumstances may be relevant to an application:
- (a) the applicant's exceptional medical needs;
  - (b) the applicant's exceptional social needs;
  - (c) any exceptional difficulty experienced by a carer for any resident;
  - (d) the applicant's exceptional employment situation which requires that the applicant's vehicle be parked of necessity for business purposes near the applicant's home.
- (2) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a special parking permit or a special parking permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council or authorised agent such evidence in respect of an application for a special parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any special parking permit granted or issued by them as they may reasonably call for to verify that the special parking permit is valid.

### **Terms and effect of special parking permits**

37. (1) A special parking permit shall be granted or issued subject to such terms and conditions as the Council's Designated Officer shall think fit.
- (2) A special parking permit shall authorise the user of the vehicle identified by the applicant to leave the vehicle specified therein:
- (a) in any parking place, or part thereof, and
  - (b) on such day or days, during such periods and at such times during the permitted hours, and
  - (c) subject to such conditions or limitations as shall be indicated on the permit or by hand-held device in relation to the permit.

- (3) A special parking permit shall be valid for such a period as the Council's Designated Officer shall think fit but in any event no longer than a period of twelve months from the date the permit first becomes valid.
- (4) The Council's Designated Officer may grant or issue any special parking permit free of charge or may make such a charge as appears to be reasonable in the circumstances of each application having due regard to the charges for residents' permits.

#### **Refund of charge paid in respect of special parking permits**

38. A special permit holder who surrenders a special permit to the Council whether before or after it becomes valid will not be entitled to a refund of the charges paid unless the Council in its discretion considers that there are exceptional circumstances to justify refunding the charge in full or in part.

#### **Withdrawal and validity of special parking permits**

39. (1) The Council may, by notice in writing served on the special parking permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the special parking permit holder at the address provided by that person at time of application for the permit, or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a special parking permit if it appears to the Council's Designated Officer that there are sufficient reasons to justify withdrawal of the special parking permit having regard to the circumstances of the permit holder, insofar as they may be known, and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of receipt of the aforementioned notice.
- (2) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article, a special parking permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified at time of granting or issue, or on the occurrence of the events set out in paragraph (1) of this Article, whichever is the earlier.
- (3) Where a special parking permit is issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque or credit card and the payment is subsequently dishonoured, the special parking permit shall cease to be of any effect and the Council shall be notice in writing served on the person to whom such permit was granted or issued by sending the same by recorded delivery service to the permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the special parking permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, require that person to surrender the special parking permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.

#### **Application for and grant or issue of duplicate special parking permits**

40. (1) If a special parking permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the special parking permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the special parking permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate special parking permit and the Council, upon receipt of the special parking permit, shall grant or issue a duplicate special parking permit, so marked where issued as a

printed document, and upon such grant or issue the original special parking permit shall become invalid.

- (2) If a special parking permit is lost or destroyed, the special parking permit holder may apply to the Council or authorised agent for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate special parking permit and the Council upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction, shall grant or issue a duplicate special parking permit, so marked where issued as a printed document, and upon such grant or issue the original special parking permit shall become invalid.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate special parking permit and an application therefor as if it were a special parking permit or, as the case may be, an application therefor.

### **Restriction on the removal of special parking permits**

41. Where a special parking permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the special parking permit unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle. Provided that nothing herein shall apply to a civil enforcement officer or a person removing the vehicle in pursuance of an arrangement made by a civil enforcement officer by or under regulations in pursuance of powers contained in sections 99, 100, 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### **Form of special parking permits**

42. Where issued as a printed document, a special parking permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
  - (1) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 39, the special parking permit shall remain valid;
  - (2) an indication that the parking permit has been issued by the Council;
  - (3) an indication of the parking zone with which the special parking permit is valid.

### **Application for and grant or issue of DHV permits**

43. (1) Any healthcare organisation recognised by the Council that uses a vehicle or vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1) for the purposes of undertaking essential medical visits by healthcare professionals may apply to the Council for the grant or issue of a DHV permit relating to the parking zone or parking zones in which their healthcare organisation is located or operates in respect of that vehicle or vehicles and any such application shall be made by way of the Council's on-line parking permits application system, accessed by way of the Council's website, and shall include the particulars and information required by such application system to be supplied.
- (2) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a DHV permit or a DHV permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council or authorised agent such evidence in respect of an application for a DHV permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any DHV permit granted or issued by them as they may reasonably call for to verify that the business permit is valid.

- (3) Upon receipt of an application duly made under the foregoing provisions of this Article, and upon receipt of such charge relating to a DHV permit as may be set from time to time by the Council, the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a healthcare organisation recognised by the Council and is the user of a vehicle or vehicles of the class specified in Article 4(1), shall grant or issue to the applicant therefor one or more DHV permits for the leaving during the permitted hours in a parking place of the vehicle or vehicles to which such DHV permit relates by the user of such vehicle or vehicles or by any person using such vehicle or vehicles with the consent of the user, other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward.

Provided that the Council reserves the right to limit the number of DHV permits granted or issued to a healthcare organisation in any one year.

#### **Refund of charge paid in respect of DHV permits**

44. A DHV holder who surrenders a DHV permit to the Council whether before or after it becomes valid will not be entitled to a refund of the charges paid unless the Council in its discretion considers that there are exceptional circumstances to justify refunding the charge in full or in part.

#### **Surrender, withdrawal and validity of DHV permits**

45. (1) A DHV permit holder may surrender a DHV permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender a DHV permit to the Council on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article or in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article.
- (2) The Council may by notice in writing served on the DHV permit holder by sending the same by the recorded delivery service to the DHV permit holder at the address provided by the healthcare organisation at time of application for the DHV permit or at any other address believed to be their place of business, withdraw a DHV permit if it appears to the Council that any of the events set out in paragraph (3)(a) or (b) of this Article has occurred and the DHV permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council or authorised agent within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.
- (3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:
- (a) the DHV permit holder ceasing to be an healthcare organisation recognised by the Council at the address in respect of which the DHV permit was granted or issued;
  - (b) the DHV permit holder ceasing to be the user of the vehicle or vehicles in respect of which the DHV permit was granted or issued;
  - (c) the withdrawal of such DHV permit by the Council under the provision of paragraph (2) of this Article;
  - (d) the grant or issue of a duplicate DHV permit by the Council under the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article.
- (4) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article a DHV permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period specified at time of

granting or issue or on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph 3(a), (b), (c) or (d) of this Article whichever is the earlier.

#### **Application for and grant or issue of duplicate DHV permits**

46. (1) If a DHV permit issued as a printed document is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figure or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the DHV permit has become altered by fading or otherwise the DHV permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council or apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate DHV permit and the Council upon receipt of the DHV permit shall grant or issue a duplicate DHV permit, so marked where issued as a printed document, and upon such grant or issue the DHV permit shall become invalid.
- (2) If a DHV permit issued as a printed document is lost or destroyed the DHV permit holder may apply to the Council for the grant or issue to them of a duplicate DHV permit and the Council upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction shall grant or issue a duplicate DHV permit, so marked where issued as a printed document, and upon such issue the DHV permit shall become invalid.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate DHV permit and an application therefor as if it were a DHV permit or as the case may be an application therefor.

#### **Restriction on the removal of DHV permits**

47. Where a DHV permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 no person other than the driver of the vehicle shall remove the DHV permit unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle provided that nothing herein shall apply to a civil enforcement officer or a person removing the vehicle in pursuance of an arrangement made by the civil enforcement officer by or under regulations in pursuance of powers contained in sections 99, 100, 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

#### **Form of DHV permits**

48. Where issued as a printed document, a DHV permit shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:
  - (1) the registration marks of the vehicle or vehicles in respect of which the DHV permit has been issued;
  - (2) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 45(4), the DHV permit shall remain valid;
  - (3) an indication that the DHV permit has been issued by the Council;
  - (4) an indication of the parking zone or parking zones within which the DHV permit is valid.

## **PART IV – WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS**

### **Waiting and loading restrictions applicable to restricted streets**

49. (1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the prescribed hours in any restricted street except, subject to the provisions of the next paragraph, for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the street.
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle:
- (a) in any restricted street or part of street during the restricted hours; or
  - (b) without prejudice to the provisions of the last foregoing sub-paragraph for a period of more than twenty minutes in the same place during the prescribed hours in any restricted street.

### **Waiting restrictions applicable to restricted streets in respect of certain classes of vehicle**

50. (1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle of the following class, that is: a heavy commercial vehicle, as defined in section 138 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as having an operational weight in excess of 7.5 tonnes, to wait in any restricted street in respect of which there is a prohibition by waiting of vehicles of that class applicable at any time stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that restricted street, at any time.
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle of the following class, that is: a heavy commercial vehicle, as defined in section 138 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as having an operational weight in excess of 7.5 tonnes, to wait in any restricted street in respect of which there is a prohibition by waiting of vehicles of that class applicable between the hours of midnight and 7 a.m. and between the hours of 8 p.m. and midnight on Monday to Saturday and at any time on Sunday stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that restricted street, during those hours.
- (3) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle of the following class, that is: a vehicle having a maximum gross weight in excess of 3 tonnes, to wait in any restricted street in respect of which there is a prohibition by waiting of vehicles of that class applicable at any time stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that restricted street, at any time.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle of the following class, that is: a vehicle having a length under 17 metres (55 feet) or a width under 2.9 metres (9 feet 6 inches), to wait in any restricted street in respect of which there is a prohibition by waiting of vehicles of that class applicable at any time stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that restricted street, at any time.

### **Stopping restrictions applicable to restricted streets**

51. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest in any restricted street during the no stopping hours.

### **Stopping restrictions applicable to school keep clear markings**

52. Subject to Article 59, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest on any school keep clear marking during the no stopping hours stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that school keep clear marking.

### **Waiting or stopping restrictions applicable to taxi ranks**

53. (1) Subject to Article 59, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a taxi to wait on a taxi rank during the prescribed hours, where stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that taxi rank.
- (2) Subject to Article 59, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a taxi to stop or remain at rest on a taxi rank during the no stopping hours, where stated by way of the map schedule legend or the tile label, or both, in respect of that taxi rank.
- (3) The driver of a taxi waiting in a taxi rank shall cause it so to stand:
- (a) parallel to the edge of the carriageway and so that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres; and
  - (b) so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the taxi rank.
- (4) The driver of any taxi using a taxi rank shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is position in the taxi rank and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the taxi rank.
- (5) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a taxi rank for any purpose other than the provision of a taxi service.

## **PART V – EXCEPTIONS TO AND EXEMPTIONS FROM WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS**

### **Persons boarding or alighting from vehicles**

54. Nothing in Article 49 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted street for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling any person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage.

### **Disabled Person's Vehicles**

55. The restrictions imposed by Article 49(1) shall not apply in relation to a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.

Provided that:

- (i) where the prescribed hours are of a period of more than three hours duration, that vehicle may wait for a period of no more than three hours (being a period not separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same street on the same day); and
- (iii) the period of waiting by that vehicle lies entirely outside any restricted hours during which a prohibition on loading or unloading applies by virtue of Article 49(2)(a).

### **Excepted vehicles in relation to restricted streets**

56. The restrictions imposed by Articles 49, 50 and 51 shall not apply in relation to the following vehicles, that is to say –
- (a) a bus used in the operation of a local service, whilst waiting at an authorised stopping place or at a terminal or turning point;
  - (b) vehicles when used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (c) vehicles when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
  - (d) vehicles waiting in any street for so long as may be necessary in connection with the taking in of petrol, oil, water or air, if such taking in cannot be effected unless the vehicle waits in the place where it is waiting.

### **Furniture removals and other exceptional loading or unloading**

57. Nothing in Article 49 of this Order shall apply so as to restrict the loading or unloading of any vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in any restricted street in connection with the removal of furniture to or from one office, dwelling-house or depository adjacent to that restricted street from or to another office, dwelling-house or depository.

Provided that this paragraph shall not apply to a vehicle waiting in any restricted street to which the provisions of Article 49(2)(a) apply.

### **Miscellaneous exemptions in relation to restricted streets**

58. (1) Nothing in Articles 49, 50 and 51 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted street:—
- (a) while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to any such restricted street in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered;
  - (b) while postal packets are being collected for loading on the vehicle from premises or posting boxes in or adjacent to any such restricted street in which the vehicle is waiting or, having been so collected, are being loaded thereon;
  - (c) while the vehicle is being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to any such restricted street, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in any street, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of any street, the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to any street of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any electronic communications network, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot reasonably be used for that purpose while waiting in any other place;
  - (d) while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises, to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait in any other place while such gate or barrier is being opened or closed.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 49, 50 and 51 shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer or where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop or wait or remain at rest or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident.
- (3) Nothing in Article 51 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on any restricted street during the no stopping hours in relation to that restricted street, if that vehicle thereupon remains at rest for any reason specified in paragraph (1) of this Article.

## **Exemptions in relation to school keep clear markings and taxi ranks**

59. Nothing in Articles 52 or 53 shall apply to:

- (a) a person causing a vehicle to stop if that person is:-
  - (i) required by law to do so;
  - (ii) obliged to stop the vehicle so as to avoid an accident;
  - (iii) prevented from proceeding in the vehicle by circumstances beyond their control;
  - (iv) getting or giving help in consequence of an accident or an emergency, or otherwise taking action for public safety;
  - (v) using the vehicle on any occasion for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of the provisions of this Order would hinder the use of the vehicle;
  - (vi) using the vehicle in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
  - (vii) using the vehicle in connection with the servicing, maintenance, improvement, reconstruction or operation of the highway or any feature thereon; or
- (b) anything done with the permission or at the discretion of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

## **PART VI – SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS**

### **Duty to move on**

60. Notwithstanding any exception or exemption contained in this Order, the person in control of a vehicle waiting during the prescribed hours in any restricted street shall move the vehicle on the instructions of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing or removing obstruction.

### **Restrictions on methods of loading or unloading vehicles**

61. (1) No person shall cause any goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from any vehicle in any restricted street otherwise than in accordance with the following conditions, that is to say –
- (a) no such goods shall be deposited on any carriageway or footway except on the carriageway immediately at the rear of the vehicle and no goods shall remain on any carriageway before the arrival of or after the departure of the vehicle;
  - (b) no part of any rope, chain, wire, apparatus or machinery used in connection with such loading or unloading, and no load suspended therefrom, shall be less than 4.88 metres above a carriageway, except when over any vehicle being loaded or unloaded or less than 2.74 metres above the footway;
  - (c) no such goods shall be passed from hand to hand across any part of any carriageway or footway:
    - Provided that nothing in this Article shall apply in relation to –
    - (i) any vehicle specified in Article 58(1)(c) or (d) or any vehicle while it is being used as mentioned in Article 58(1)(c); or
    - (ii) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- (2) Nothing in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of this Article shall apply to any pipe, apparatus or machinery being used in connection with the loading or unloading of any petrol, water, oil, or liquid fuel on to or from any vehicle in any street or from any premises adjacent to any street, provided that all necessary means are taken to give adequate warning of any possible obstruction.

### **Restriction on street trading**

62. No person shall sell, offer or expose for sale goods from a vehicle which is in any restricted street unless:-
- (a) that person is licensed by the Council to sell goods from a stationary vehicle on a pitch in that street and sells goods from that pitch; or
  - (b) the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

### **Suspension of taxi ranks**

63. (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council or the Police may suspend the use of any taxi rank or any part thereof whenever that person considers such suspension reasonably necessary:
- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
  - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the taxi rank or the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the taxi rank or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the taxi rank of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications network or traffic sign;
  - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the taxi rank on any occasion of the removal of furniture from the office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
  - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the taxi rank at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (2) A police constable in uniform or an authorised person may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a taxi rank or any part thereof whenever that person considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- (3) Any person suspending the use of a taxi rank or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that taxi rank or the part thereof the use of which is suspended, a traffic sign indicating that waiting or stopping, as the case may be, by vehicles is prohibited.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait or stop, as the case may be, in any part of a taxi rank during such period as there is in or adjacent to that part of the taxi rank a traffic sign placed in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of this Article.

### **Contravention of this Order in relation to waiting, loading and stopping restrictions**

64. (1) If a vehicle is waiting or stopping, as the case may be, in a restricted street or on a school keep clear marking or taxi rank during the prescribed hours or restricted hours or no stopping hours, as the case may be, in respect of that restricted street or school keep clear marking or taxi rank without complying with the provisions of this Order, then a contravention of, or failure to comply with this Order shall be deemed to have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform in accordance with The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic

Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022.

- (3) The penalty charge shall be paid to Three Rivers District Council in accordance with the instructions and within the time limits specified on the penalty charge notice.

**PART VII - REVOCATION**

**Orders to be revoked**

65. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Orders listed in Schedule 4 are hereby revoked, either wholly, or in part insofar as any of their provisions are in conflict with or are superseded by the provisions of this Order in relation to their effect within the Three Rivers District but remain in force elsewhere, as the case may be.

## **SCHEDULE 3 - PARKING AND PERMIT CHARGES**

### **Amount of the parking charge at ticket machines and using the electronic payment system**

1. The parking charge referred to in Article 15(1) shall be payable either at a ticket machine or using the electronic payment system at the rate of four pounds (£4.00) for an 'all day' stay during the permitted hours on any one day.

### **Residents' permits**

2. The charge referred to in Articles 19(1), 19(2) and 19(4) (in relation to the grant or issue of a residents' permit), shall be as follows:-

- (a) in the case of a residents' permit valid for use in parking zones A, A1, B, C, C1, E, BED, RG, NS, GS or NL:

- (i) in respect of the first residents' permit granted or issued per household, the sum of seventy seven pounds (£77.00) in respect of a permit which, subject to the provisions of this Order, shall be valid for a period of twelve months commencing from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid;
- (ii) in respect of the second residents' permit granted or issued per household, where available, the sum of one hundred and forty two pounds (£142.00) in respect of a permit which, subject to the provisions of this Order, shall be valid for a period of twelve months commencing from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid;

Provided that no second residents' permit shall available in the case of applications made in respect of parking zones E and BED.

- (b) in the case of a residents' permit valid for use in parking zones CG, D, OW, OZ and W.

- (i) in respect of the first residents' permit granted or issued per household, the sum of thirty-nine pounds (£39.00) in respect of a permit which, subject to the provisions of this Order, shall be valid for a period of twelve months commencing from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid; and
- (ii) in respect of the second residents' permit granted or issued per household, the sum of seventy-one pounds (£71.00) in respect of a permit which, subject to the provisions of this Order, shall be valid for a period of twelve months commencing from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid.

### **Business permits**

3. The charges referred to in Article 26(3) (in relation to the issue of a business permit), shall be the sum of two hundred and fifty seven pounds (£257.00) or five hundred and sixty three or six hundred and ninety two (£692.00) in respect of a permit which, subject to the provisions of this order, shall be valid for a period of

twelve months commencing from the beginning of the month in which the permit first became valid.

### **Visitor's permits**

4. The charge referred to in Article 32(3) (in relation to the issue of visitor's permits), shall be as follows:-
  - (a) in the case of one-day residents' visitor's permits ('visitor vouchers'), each valid for up to a maximum of 24 hours from the time and date indicated on or at time of purchase of the permit:-
    - (i) in the case of one-day residents' visitor's permits valid for use in parking zones A, A1, B, C, C1, E, BED, RG, NS, GS or NL, RW sixteen pounds (£16.00) for a set of ten one-day residents' visitor's permits, each valid throughout the permitted hours on the day on which each individual permit is validated; and
    - (ii) in the case of one-day residents' visitor's permits valid for use in parking zones CG, D, OW, OZ and W, nine pounds (£9.00) for a set of ten one-day residents' visitor's permits, each valid throughout the permitted hours on the day on which each individual the permit is validated.
    - (iii) Provided that a 50% discount shall be applicable in respect of applications for one-day residents' visitor's permits made by residents who are over 60 years of age, where such application is made together with proof of age.

### **Administration fee**

5. The administration fee payable:-
  - (a) on applying to the Council or authorised agent for a duplicate residents' permit, duplicate business permit, or annual residents' visitor's permit shall be twenty pounds (£20.00); and
  - (b) on surrendering a permit to the Council or authorised agent for refund or partial refund shall be fifteen pounds (£15.00).
